

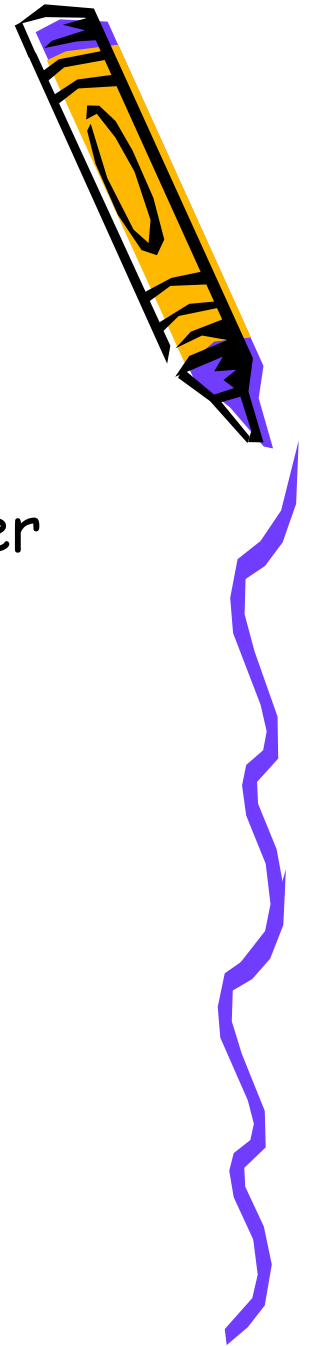

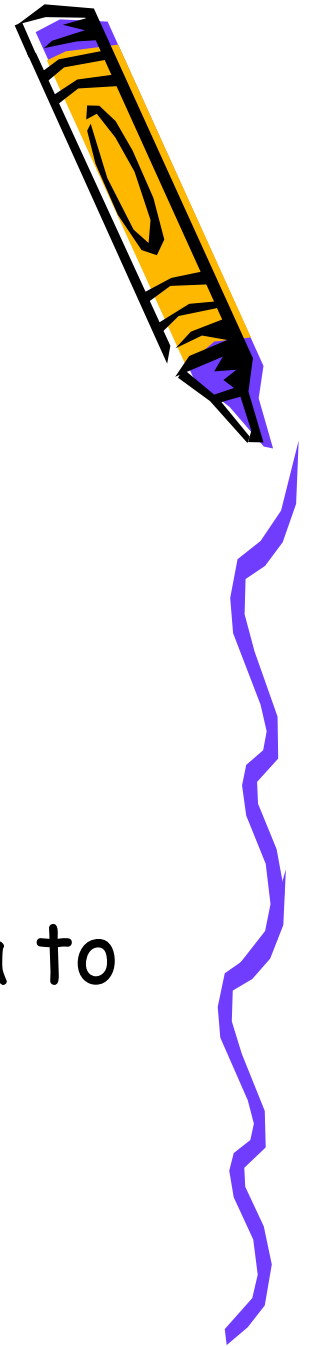
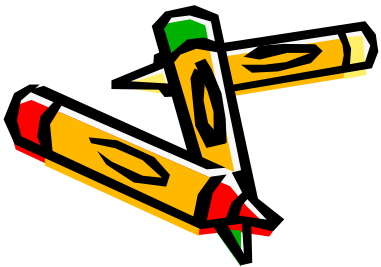
Registration Process

- Step 6: Receive final 2011-2012 class schedule in August 2011



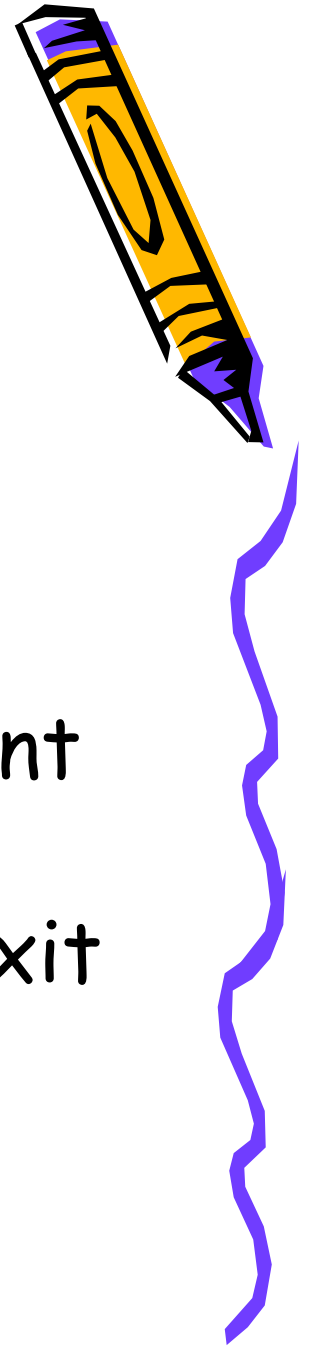
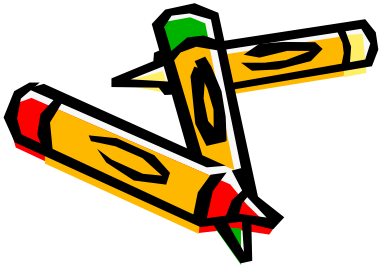

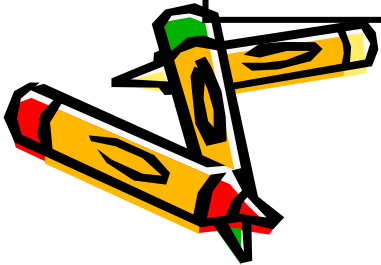
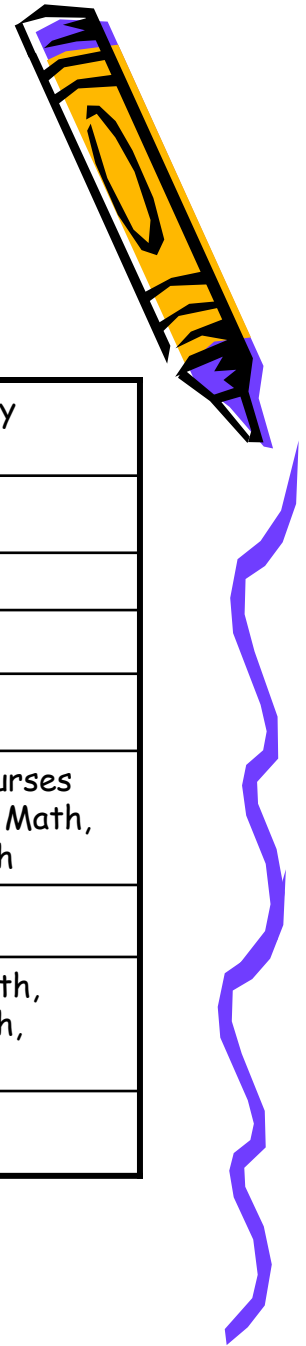
- Successfully complete all subject requirements

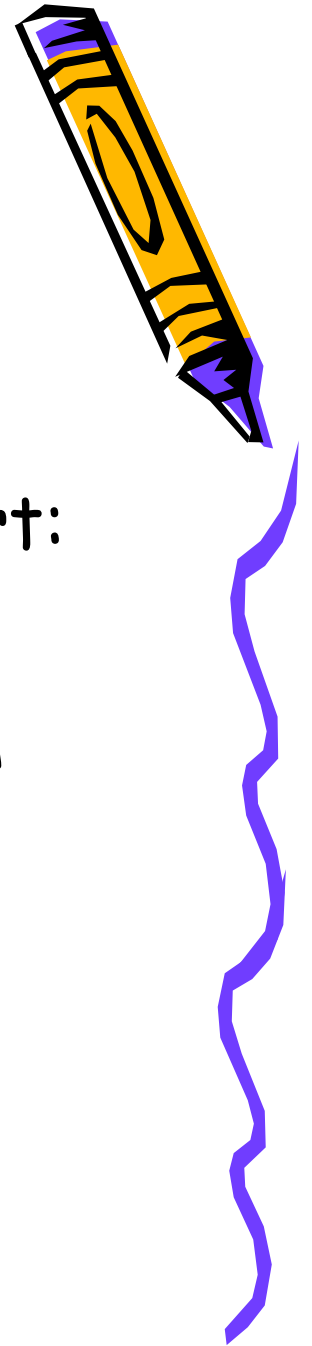

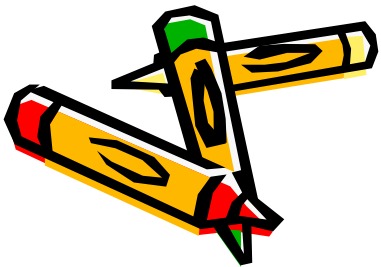
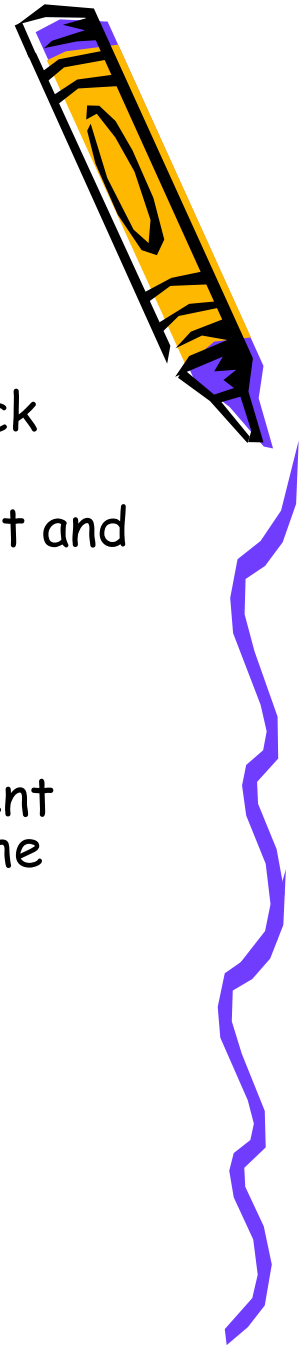
Special Admit Classes

- Auditions/Interviews

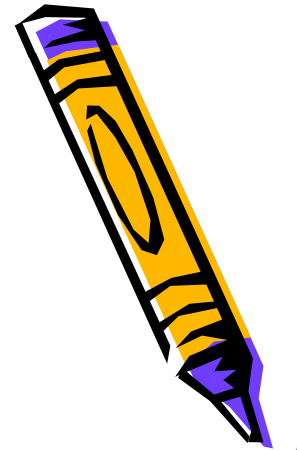


Things to know
