- Special part time program
- Opportunity for 12th grade students to start earning college credit
- Dual enrollment during the school day
(4 periods LHS, 2 periods Madera Center)
- Dual credit
- Opportunity to earn 11 to 14 college credits
- Most credits are transferable to four-year universities

Selection Criteria

- 2.5 or higher high school g.p.a.
 - Good attendance
 - Good behavior
 - Placement test in Math and English
 - Parent, Counselor, Principal, and College Counselor approval

 - 1 core, 1 elective
- Monday – Friday (8:15 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.)
- Fall and Spring orientation
- Provide own transportation and books
- 6 week, 12 week, and Semester grades
- Adaptability, initiative, time management, independence, and responsibility
