Why should I take	To minimize your "rate of forgetting"
Notes?	No notes = Forget 60% in 14 Days
	Take some notes = Remember 60%
	Take organized notes & study = 90-100%
When should I take	Notes are a record & should be taken when: listening to
Notes?	A lecture, reading a text, watching a film, group activities –
	All the time!
What is so different about	It is divided into two parts: 1) Questions/Main Ideas
Cornell notes?	2)Reflection at the end – It is labeled in detail
What types of questions	Questions which are answered in the notes on the right.
Should I place in the left	Questions you need an answer to, Vocabulary, key phrases,
Hand side?	Diagrams/pictures, Reference pages, dates, steps in a
	Solution process, note to self to remember something
What are some good tips	Write what is most important, listen for things a teacher
For taking notes on the	Repeats, watch for clues, anything written, paraphrase,
Right?	Abbreviate, draw a figure or diagram, bullets.(write legibly)
